Our training and qualifications for workers and managers have been designed to help achieve a fully competent workforce in line with the Home Office/NTA Joint Workforce Development Plan and DANOS 2012.

Line managers

OU/FDAP Professional Award for Managers of Drug & Alcohol Practitioners

[Assessment only qualification / Open to all]

An Open University qualification based on an assessment of competence against four units from DANOS and the Management & Leadership and Education & Learning National Occupational Standards (NOS). Cost: £440 (10% off for FDAP members/corporate affiliates).

ASET/FDAP Certificate in Supervisory Management & Leadership Techniques

[Training based qualification / Open to all]

ASET-accredited four day training course leading to a level 3 award for line managers in the drugs and alcohol field. The course focuses on the same units covered by the OU/FDAP award for managers. Cost: TBC (preferential rate for FDAP members/affiliates).

Performance Management + Supervision, Appraisal & DANOS

[Training only / Open to all]

Two one-day workshops providing practical training on using DANOS and other national occupational standards in managing and developing front line workers. Cost (each): £110 + VAT (15% reduction for FDAP members/affiliates) - group rates on application.

Front line workers

FDAP Drug & Alcohol Professional Certification

[Assessment only certification / Open to FDAP members and affiliate agencies]

A competence-based certification, covering 10 units from DANOS and related NOS, and providing evidence of workplace competence in line with national targets. Cost: £75 (reductions available to FDAP affiliates).

OU/FDAP Professional Awards for Drug & Alcohol Practitioners

[Assessment only qualification / Open to all]

Open University qualifications providing externally-validated evidence of competence against units from DANOS and other relevant NOS - including a 10 unit Professional Award for Drug & Alcohol Practitioners and smaller Professional Development Awards. Cost: from £245 (10% off for FDAP members/affiliates).

FDAP National Counsellor Accreditation Certificate (NCAC)

[Assessment only certification / Open to FDAP members and affiliate agencies]

A specialist certification for drug and alcohol counsellors - conferring eligibility to the United Kingdom Register of Counsellors (UKRC) and complementing FDAP's Drug & Alcohol Professional Certification. Cost: £150 (reductions available to FDAP affiliates).

FDAP/AC Introductory Certificate for Drug & Alcohol Counsellors

[Assessment only certification / Open to all]

A certification from FDAP and Alcohol Concern aimed at counsellors in training and volunteer counsellors working in alcohol and drugs services. Cost: £75 (£50 for FDAP members/affiliates and Alcohol Concern members).

The essential drug and alcohol worker

[Training only / Open to all]

This 5-day course provides a full introduction to many of the elements of effective drugs and alcohol work - run by Tim Morrison and developed in association with DrugScope. Cost: £635 + VAT (15% reduction for FDAP members/affiliates) - group rates on application.

Specialist workshops and short courses

[Training only / Open to all]

We also run specialist workshops and courses for front line practitioners on clinical issues (such as working with stimulant users). Further details of forthcoming courses can be found on the FDAP website (www.fdap.org.uk).
