Proposer Statement

This must be completed by the person proposing the applicant's NCAC accreditation.

A Proposer should generally fall in to one of the following categories - a holder of the FDAP NCAC accreditation; a current FDAP UK member of more than 5 years standing; UKCP registered counsellor; a BACP / UKRC registered practitioner; a BPS Chartered Psychologist; or someone holding FRCP status.

You cannot act as a Proposer if you are: a relative of the counsellor; a client or ex-client of the counsellor; a supervisor of the counsellor if acting as supervisor for this accreditation application.

You must know the counsellor to the degree that they are able to confirm that applicant is a responsible person and works in a professional manner.

Before acting as a Proposer, you should have read: FDAP Criteria for Accreditation; FDAP Code of Ethics & Practice for Practitioners; the applicant's completed application form.

As well as completing the attached, the Proposer should also sign the back of any certificates submitted by the applicant, to verify that they are true copies of the original.

[Note: Your signature on the Proposer's Statement is an indication that you are familiar with this material. You are taking responsibility for endorsing the applicant's application to be accredited when you sign the form.]
